






Where does the data come from and how is it processed?

- Building permit data is provided by local jurisdictions
 - Database includes all permits >=\$10,000 in estimated cost
 - Permits w/ estimated cost >= \$50,000 are geocoded
- Weekly building permit data system maintenance
 - Upload of permits received from local jurisdictions
 - Conversion of permits to a regional coding system
 - Data review and quality control





Exhibit 1: New Residential Unit Permit Activity (13-Month)










