The Town of Easton has been working for the past few months to enact the "Growth Tiers Map" required under the provisions of The Sustainable Growth and Agricultural Preservation Act of 2012. With guidance from MDP's Lower Eastern Shore Office, our planning staff has prepared draft maps, worked with our Planning Commission and Town Council and finally arrived at the map attached with this letter.
